#### 3. **Hazards identification**

Irritating to eyes and skin.

#### First aid measures 4.

After inhalation: fresh air.

After skin contact: wash off with plenty of water. Remove contaminated clothing. After eye contact: rinse out with plenty of water with the eyelid held wide open. Call in ophtalmologist.

After swallowing: make victim drink plenty of water, call in physician.

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### 5. Fire-fighting measures

Suitable extinguishing media:

In adaption to materials stored in the immediate neighbourhood.

Special risks:

Non-combustible. Ambient fire may liberate hazardous vapours.

Special protective equipment for fire fighting:

Do not stay in dangerous zone without self-contained breathing apparatus. In order to avoid contact with skin, keep a safety distance and wear suitable protective clothing.

Other information:

Contain escaping vapours with water. Prevent fire-fighting water from entering surface water or groundwater.

Procedures for cleaning / absorption:

Take up with liquid-absorbent and neutralizing material (e.g. Chemizorb® H<sup>+</sup>, Art. No. 101595). Forward for disposal. Clean up affected area.

Personal protective equipment:

gastrointestinal tract.

Other notes:

The following applies to zinc compounds in general: only slightly absorbable via the gastrointestinal tract. Adstringent effect on mucous membranes. Metal-fume fever after inhalation of large quantities.

The following applies to nitrites/nitrates in general: methaemoglobinaemia after the uptake of large quantities.

### 12. Ecological information

Ecotoxic effects:

Quantitative data on the ecological effect of this product are not available.

Further ecologic data:

The following applies to nitrates in general: may contribute to the eutrophication of water supplies. Hazard for drinking water. Fish:  $LC_{50} > 500$  mg/l.

The following applies to soluble zinc compounds in general: Inorganic zinc salts have a bactericidal effect. From >10 mg Zn/l on, the bacteriological self-purification of water is inhibited or suppressed. Toxic for water organisms. Lethal for fish from 0.1 mg/l in soft water. Fish toxicity:  $LC_{50}$  (L. idus) 21 mg/l (ZnCl $_2$ ); zinc ions: toxic to Daphnia magna from 0.3 mg/l. Contamination of ground water involves risks for drinking water catchment.

No ecological problems are to be expected when the product is handled and used with due care and attention.
